Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Emergency Backup Generators To Serve Magnolia Street Well And North Peachtree Street Well – DWDRA20003** will be received, by the City of Warwick, at **Warwick Community Center –111 Dogwood Street, Warwick, GA 31796**, until **2:00 PM** local time on **March 15, 2022**, at which time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read. No bids maybe withdrawn after the closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days except as specifically detailed in the Instructions to Bidders. The Project consists of **1 new 80KW/100KVA, 480/277V, 3 phase, 4 wire standby diesel generator and 1 new 100KW/125KVA, 480/277V, 3 phase, 4 wire standby diesel generator**, along with generator control panels, generator enclosures, automatic transfer switches, concrete generator pads, complete electrical appurtenances, generator start up services, and all additional appurtenances needed for complete generator installations.

Bids submitted via mail shall be mailed to the City of Warwick at Warwick City Hall – P.O. Box 59, Warwick, Georgia 31796.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with any alternate bid items if indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **8:30 AM – 5:00 P.M.**, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at **Warwick City Hall**; during the City's regular business hours.

Bidding Documents are available electronically (as portable document format (PDF) files) for a non-refundable charge of **\$225.00**. Paper copies of bid documents are also available for an additional **\$100.00** non-refundable charge.

Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, Bidding Documents will be sent via email or other means of electronic file distribution. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. **Bids will not be accepted from prospective bidders not on record with the Issuing Office as having purchased and received a complete set of Bidding Documents.**

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. If awarded the Contract the successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount. Bonds must be

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provided by sureties appearing on the U.S. Treasury Department's most current Circular 570 Listing and be licensed in the State of Georgia.

All permits required for the construction of this project are expected to be approved prior to the date of the bid opening.

Acquisition of property for easements, right of way, etc. is not expected to be required for this project.

This project is expected to be funded all or in part by the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority's (GEFA) Drinking Water State Revolving Loan fund, via the Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act (ASADRA) for water projects for Georgia cities, counties or water authorities that were impacted by Hurricane Michael. The construction contract will be subject to GEFA's Supplemental General Conditions for Federally Assisted State Revolving Loan Fund Construction Contracts including Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements and Davis Bacon & Related Act requirements. Additionally, the contract will be subject to GEFA's American Iron and Steel Special Conditions and Information for Federally Assisted State Revolving Loan Fund Construction Contracts.
