Sealed Bids for the construction of the Sanitary Sewer System Improvements – West Circle, Palmer St., N. Butler St., & Marietta St. Area, Project – FY 2020 CDBG, Still Waters Eng. Project No.: C0113.008 will be received, by the City of Camilla, at the Camilla City Hall – 30 East Broad Street, Camilla, Georgia 31730, until **10:00 AM** local time on **April 8, 2021**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days. The Project consists of constructing +/- 2,600 LF 8" gravity sewer main, +/- 290 LF 15" gravity sewer main, +/-950 LF of 8" cured in place piping, +/- 1,300 LF of 15" cured in place piping and +/- 2,170 SY concrete sidewalk, along with additional items indicated in the Contract Documents.

Bids submitted via mail shall be mailed to City of Camilla at 30 East Broad Street, Camilla, Georgia 31730.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with any alternate bid items if indicated in the Bid Form.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is: **Still Waters Engineering, 130 Veterinary Way, Unit 2, Leesburg, GA 31763**. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **8:00 AM – 5:00 PM**, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at **Camilla City Hall, during the City's regular business hours.**

Bidding Documents are available electronically (as portable document format (PDF) files) for a non-refundable charge of **\$250.00**. Paper copies of bid documents are also available for an additional **\$100.00** non-refundable charge. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, Bidding Documents will be sent via email or other means of electronic file distribution. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. **Bids will not be accepted from prospective bidders not on record with the Issuing Office as having purchased and received a complete set of Bidding Documents.**

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. If awarded the Contract the successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount. Bonds must be provided by sureties appearing on the U.S. Treasury Department's most current Circular 570 Listing and be licensed in the State of Georgia.

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All permits required for the construction of this project are expected to be approved prior to the date of the bid opening.

Acquisition of property for permanent easements, right of way, etc. is not expected to be required for this project.
