The Project consists of **+/- 2700 LF of assorted storm drainage piping ranging from 18"-48, +/- 6636 LF of 24" curb and gutter, +/- 20 storm drainage drop inlets, and +/- 714 TONS of 1-1/2" 9.5 mm Superpave Asphalt.**
