Proposals for the construction of the **Generators for Pump Station & Well Improvements** will be received, by **Still Waters Engineering**, at – **130 Veterinary Way Unit 2, Leesburg, GA 31763**, until **4:30 PM** local time on **February 5, 2021**, at which time the Proposals received will be privately opened and read. Proposals can be sent in by mail to the address shown above or proposals can be emailed to Chad Griffin, project engineer at cgriffin@stillwaterseng.com. The Project consists of a materials and labor bid that will include providing a new 50 kw, 480/277V, 3 phase, 4 wire portable trailer mounted diesel generator, 5 generator cam lock connection boxes, 5 manual transfer switches, a new 130 kw, 480/277, 3 phase, 4 wire stationary diesel generator, automatic transfer switch, concrete generator pad, and all additional appurtenances needed for a complete generator installation.

Proposals will be received for a single prime materials and labor contract. Proposals shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with alternate bid items as indicated in the Proposal Form.

Bidding Documents will be sent via email or other means of electronic file distribution. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security will not be required for this project and bidding documents will only be sent to responsible bidders with experience in this form of construction.

All permits required for this project have been approved prior to the date of the proposal opening.

Acquisition of property for easements, right of way, etc. is not required for this project.

This project is expected to be funded all or in part by the Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (GEMA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) and the City of Boston. Materials and labor should be included in the bid form attached in the bidding documents.
